GRADING PROJECTS

Highway 845—Urban to Rural—2022

Project consisted of the conversion of a dirt rural roadway to an urban standard with significant underground installation of new facilities in the Town of Raymond.

Eagle worked with McNally Contractors in new road construction for realignment & intersection improvement, Including:



* Stormwater Management Design to tie in new facilities with existing infrastructure.

* Accommodation of paved walking trail and conversion to urban cross-section highway design.

* Construction of an extension for Railway Avenue was a welcome feature for the citizens.

Highway 817—Detailed engineering designs spanning over 17 years.

Construction spanned two seasons—2022 and 2023. Upgrades and revisions of over 10 kms of highway, including various connector roads and intersections in the Carseland Area.

Work on this project included:

- Realignment route studies and land acquisition, including legal surveys.
- Multifaceted utility coordination and relocations.
- Extensive environmental studies and Water Act coordination.
- Involvement of historical and paleontology resources.
- Coordination with Treaty 7 First Nation communities.
- Bridge demolition and installation coordination.
- 24 hr operations to allow for overnight paving.
